4. Title: Establish penalty for violating the Unified Carrier Registration System

5. Summary: This legislation provides that any operator of a motor vehicle not in compliance with the federal Unified Carrier Registration System shall be guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor, which could result in a fine up to \$250.
