- **5. Summary:** The enrolled bill changes the composition and appointment powers to the Board of Visitors at Eastern Virginia Medical School (EVMS). The legislation provides for the Governor, House and Senate to make appointments to nonlegislative citizens at large. Additional appointment power is granted to the Senate Rules Committee, Speaker of the House of Delegates, and Governor.
- 6. No Fiscal Impact. Final.
- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The legislation changes the composition and alters the way in which the Eastern Virginia Medical School Board of Visitors is appointed. The Board will consist of 17 members, with the following appointments: two members appointed at large by the Governor, three members appointed at large by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, two members appointed at large by the Senate Committee on Rules, six members to be appointed by the Eastern Virginia Medical School Foundation, and four members to be appointed by the region's city councils from nominees submitted by the Board.

Effective July 1, 2009, and as vacancies on the Board occur among previous members appointed by the region's city councils, the Commonwealth's three appointing bodies shall make appointments in a rotating manner until all appointments are made. Since the number of board members stays the same, there is no fiscal impact.
