4. Title: Department of Health; certificates of free sale

5. Summary: Extends until July 1, 2010, the authority of the Department of Health to issue certificates of free sale to the manufacturer of any product defined as a “cosmetic” in the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, 21 U.S.C. 301 (i) to allow the export of such products.

8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation seeks to extend the Department of Health’s current authority to issue certificates of free sale from July 1, 2009 to July 1, 2010 to the manufacturer of any product defined as “cosmetic” in the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, 21 U.S.C. 301 (i). Based on the legislation, only one manufacturer is eligible to receive certificates of free sale from the Department of Health. Any costs incurred by this legislation are expected to be absorbed by the agency.
