**4. Title: Statewide Transportation Plan; Corridors of Statewide Significance**

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Requires the Commonwealth Transportation Board, with assistance from the Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment, to conduct an assessment of capacity needs for all identified corridors of statewide significance and networks of regional significance in the Statewide Transportation Plan. Also, requires local governments to show corridors of statewide significance on their transportation plan maps in their comprehensive plans for information purposes. Enhances the transportation planning responsibilities for the Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment including: 1) overseeing studies of potential highway, transit, rail and other improvements, such as access management, to help address mobility and accessibility needs in corridors of statewide significance and regional networks; 2) work with regional organizations to develop transportation and land use performance measures; 3) provide technical assistance to local governments and regional entities in establishing Urban Development Areas; 4) establish standards for the coordination of transportation investments; 5) promote commuter choice and transportation system efficiency. Bill also requires the Board to establish a plan for the identification of and acquisition of rights of way that may be needed in these statewide corridors and conduct environmental assessments for such corridors.
