**4. Title: Richard Daley Mahone Memorial Bridge; John McLaughlin Memorial Bridge.**

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Designates the Virginia Route 143 (Merrimac Trail) bridge over Queens Creek in Williamsburg the "Richard Daley Mahone Memorial Bridge" and the Virginia Route 64 (Old Roxbury Road) that crosses Interstate 64 in New Kent County the "John McLaughlin Memorial Bridge."

Fiscal implications:** Only the New Kent naming (John McLaughlin Memorial Bridge) impacts VDOT, which will fabricate and erect those signs, only at such time as the County has committed to reimbursing VDOT costs as required by §33.1-12(4) of the Code of Virginia. VDOT estimates those costs to total \$800 (2 signs for \$400 each).
