5. Summary/Purpose: The bill repeals the Virginia Indigent Health Care Trust Fund. The fund was created July 1, 1989, as a public/private partnership involving the state government and private acute care hospitals in the state in an effort to equalize the burden of charity care among the hospitals. The purpose of the fund is to reimburse hospitals for part of the cost of charity care. Payments from the fund go to acute care hospitals that have provided charity care in excess of the median level of charity care costs, as provided by all acute care hospitals in the state. It is funded by an appropriation from the state and contributions from hospitals that provide charity care at levels below the median charity care costs for all hospitals.
