- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary: Yes. HB 1600/SB 850 as introduced eliminates funding for this commission in the Department of Education (DOE). Therefore, an appropriation would need to be established in the legislative branch. The legislation indicates that expenses should be paid from existing appropriations or, if unfunded, shall be approved by the Joint Rules Committee.
