- **3. Committee:** Local Government
- 4. Title: Breaks Regional Airport Authority.
- **5. Summary:** Establishes the Breaks Regional Airport Authority if the Town of Grundy, or the governing body of Buchanan County, by resolution declare that there is a need for an airport authority to be created, and an operating agreement is developed for the purpose of establishing or operating airport facilities. The authority could be governed by a five member board of directors comprised of the representatives of the Town of Grundy, County of Buchanan, and County of Dickenson. The proposed Authority would have powers typically granted to airport authorities, including the legal authority to issue bonds.
- 6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: There are no direct current fiscal impacts due to the sponsorship of the airport changing from Town of Grundy to a multi-jurisdictional airport authority. The proposed bill is offered in anticipation that an airport will be reconstructed on the existing site after the existing airport is closed and mined for coal. Any future airport development, which at a minimum is five years out from reconstruction, would occur within the financial bounds of existing federal and state capital grant programs for airport development. There could be a case where the future airport authority, if formed, might issue bonds to meet their local share obligation of 2% to meet capital qualifications to participate in federal and state airport development grant programs.
