4. Title: **Board for Barbers and Cosmetology; estheticians; waiver of examination requirements.**

5. Summary: The bill extends until July 31, 2009, the grandfather period for licensure as an esthetician or master esthetician.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill has no fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: None

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: The Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No

11. Other Comments: The second enactment clause states that an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.

The third enactment clause states that, notwithstanding § 54.1-703.3, the provisions of this Act shall not apply to applications for licensure submitted to the Board for Barbers and Cosmetology prior to the effective date of this Act.

The fourth enactment clause state that DPOR shall, to the extent reasonably practicable, provide widespread notification to those affected by the provisions of this Act.

This bill is identical to HB 1718.
