Under the provisions of Chapter 819, all deputy sheriffs of localities participating in the Virginia Retirement System were provided LEOS retirement benefits. 11. Other Comments:

- The fiscal impact data in Item 6 includes eligible retirees only as of June 30, 2007. SB 400 requires that any deputy retired on disability prior to July 1, 2008 receive the additional benefits.
- The proposed legislation could create a precedent for certain other employee groups included in Chapter 819 of the Acts of Assembly of 2007 to request similar benefits.
