5.	Summary: Teacher's retirement allowance. Extends the July 1, 2010, sunset date to July 1, 2015, for provisions allowing retirees to be hired as teachers or administrative personnel without interruption of their retirement benefits.
	Such benefits are restricted to school personnel designated as serving in critical shortage areas pursuant to subdivision 4 of § 22.1-23, § 22.1-70.3, or subdivision 9 of § 22.1-79.
	Further, to be eligible, the person must have qualified break in service, and may not be receiving an early retirement incentive program from any local school division within the Commonwealth.
