**3. Committee:** Education and Health

**4. Title:**            **Institutions of higher education; employment of campus police.**

**5. Summary:** Institutions of higher education; employment of campus police. Allows any public institution of higher education to direct that its campus police officers and any auxiliary forces not be governed by the Virginia Personnel Act. Also makes a technical amendment, correcting an outdated Code citation.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** There is no fiscal impact.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal Implications:** There are no fiscal implications.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** VRS and certain institutions of higher education

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** Yes. Language is needed to further clarify that only Chiefs of Campus Police Departments may be affected by this legislation.

**11. Other Comments:** This legislation provides a technical amendment to allow campus police officers to remain in the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System (VaLORS) whether they are in a classified position or a university position not covered by the Virginia Personnel Act at the discretion of the governing Board of the public institution.
