12 Special Session I. Necessary payments to cover contingent and incidental expenses will be certified by
13 the Clerk of the Senate or her designee; and, be it

14 RESOLVED FURTHER, That members of the Senate shall receive a session per diem and mileage 15 reimbursement if in attendance at the 2009 Special Session I of the General Assembly; and, be it

16 RESOLVED FURTHER, That members of the Senate shall receive a session per diem for any day or
 17 days on which their attendance is required at a meeting of any conference committee on pending
 18 legislation upon submission to the Clerk of an attendance roll call; and, be it

19 RESOLVED FINALLY, That any member of the Senate in attendance of a daily session of Special
 20 Session I, including a pro forma session, shall not be entitled to compensation or expenses pursuant to
 21 §§ 2.2-2813 and 30-19.12 of the Code of Virginia for services performed at any meetings of legislative

committees, legislative commissions and councils and all committees and subcommittees on the same

day. All other members of the Senate shall be entitled to compensation or expenses pursuant to
§§ 2.2-2813 and 30-19.12 of the Code of Virginia for legislative services performed away from the
Capitol Square on any day that the Senate is in a pro forma session.
