An Act to amend and reenact § 33.1-19 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Commonwealth Transportation Board; rules and regulations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 33.1-19 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 33.1-19. Effect of Board's rules and regulations.

The rules and regulations together with any additions or amendments thereto, prescribed by the Board under the provisions of subdivision (3) of § 33.1-12, shall have the force and effect of law and any person, firm or corporation violating any such rule or regulation or any addition or amendment thereto shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$5 nor more than \$100 for each offense. Such person shall be civilly liable to the Commonwealth for the actual damage sustained by the Commonwealth by reason of his wrongful act. Such damages may be recovered at the suit of the Commonwealth Transportation Board and, when collected, paid into the state treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation. But no such rules and regulations or additions or amendments thereto, or repeals thereof, shall become effective until sixty days shall have elapsed following their adoption by the Board Any rules and regulations promulgated by the Board shall be developed in accordance with the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.) except when specifically exempted by law.
