CHAPTER 495

An Act to amend and reenact § 15.2-1207 of the Code of Virginia and to repeal § 15.2-1206 of the Code of Virginia, relating to certain firearms taxes; destruction of records.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 15.2-1207 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 15.2-1207. Same; reports of sales.

The *power of any* governing body of any county ~~may~~ to require sellers of pistols and revolvers to furnish the clerk of the circuit court of the county, ~~within ten days~~ after sale of any such weapon, with the name and address of the purchaser, the date of purchase, and the number, make and caliber of the weapon sold *is hereby repealed*. The clerk shall ~~keep~~ *destroy every* record of the reports *previously received*.

2. That § 15.2-1206 of the Code of Virginia is repealed.
