6	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
7	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-32.3 as follows:
8	§ 18.2-32.3 Human infant; independent and separate existence.
9	For the purposes of this article and § 18.2-371.1, the determination of an independent and separate
10	existence of a human infant from its mother shall not be conditioned solely upon whether or not the
11	umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta detached.
12	2. That the provisions of this act are declarative of existing law.
13	3. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or

3. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 781 of the Acts of Assembly of 2009 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0 for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of

Juvenile Justice.
