| 12              | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 26 of Title 2.2 an article   |

| 15<br>16        | P-16 Education Council.<br>§ 2.2-2699.5. P-16 Education Council; purpose.   |
| 17              | The P-16 Education Council (the Council) is established as an advisory council, within the meaning  |
| 18              | of § 2.2-2100, in the executive branch of state government. The purpose of the Council is to make   |
| 19              | recommendations on ways to create a seamless transition and ensure effective articulation from  |
| 20              | preschool to graduate school.   |
| 21<br>22        | § 2.2-2699.6. Membership; terms; quorum; meetings.<br>The Council shall be composed of 21 members. Four members of the House of Delegates shall be  |
| $\overline{23}$ | appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, in accordance with the principles of proportional   |
| 24              | representation contained in the Rules of the House of Delegates, and two members of the Senate shall  |
| 25              | be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules. The Governor shall appoint eight citizen members who   |
| 26<br>27        | shall include educators, and business and community leaders. The Council shall also include the Secretary of Education, the Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Executive Director of the State             |
