Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, 73 74 or preparation which contains any quantity of the following substances having a stimulant effect on the 75 central nervous system, including its salts, isomers (whether optical, position, or geometric), and salts of 76 such isomers whenever the existence of such salts, isomers, and salts of isomers is possible within the 77 specific chemical designation:

- 78 Cathine (+)-norpseudoephedrine;

90 4. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, 91 or preparation containing any of the following narcotic drugs, or their salts calculated as the free 92 anhydrous base or alkaloid, in limited quantities as set forth below:

93 Dextropropoxyphene (alpha-(+)-4-dimethylamino-1, 2-diphenyl-3-methyl-2-propionoxy butane);

94 Not more than 1 milligram of difenoxin and not less than 25 micrograms of atropine sulfate per 95 dosage unit.

96 5. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture,

- 97 or preparation which contains any quantity of the following substances, including their salts:
- 98 Butorphanol (including its optical isomers):
- 99 Pentazocine.

6. The Board may except by regulation any compound, mixture, or preparation containing any 100 101 depressant substance listed in subdivision 1 from the application of all or any part of this chapter if the 102 compound, mixture, or preparation contains one or more active medicinal ingredients not having a depressant effect on the central nervous system, and if the admixtures are included therein in 103 combinations, quantity, proportion, or concentration that vitiate the potential for abuse of the substances 104 105 which have a depressant effect on the central nervous system.
