9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 46.2-931 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 46.2-931. Localities may prohibit or regulate distribution of handbills, etc., solicitation of
12	contributions, and sale of merchandise on highways within their boundaries.
13	A. Arlington, Hanover, Henrico, and Spotsylvania Counties, the Cities of Falls Church and
14	Richmond, and the Town of Vienna are Any county, city, or town is hereby authorized to adopt
15 16	ordinances prohibiting or regulating: 1. The distribution of handbills, leaflets, bulletins, literature, advertisements, or similar material to the
17	occupants of motor vehicles on highways located within their its boundaries;
18	2. The solicitation of contributions of any nature from the occupants of motor vehicles on highways
19	located within their its boundaries; and
20 21	3. The sale of merchandise or the attempted sale of merchandise to the occupants of motor vehicles on highways located within their <i>its</i> boundaries.
²¹ 22	B. Albemarle, Greene, Hanover, Loudoun, and Spotsylvania Counties and the Cities of Falls Church
23 24	and Richmond are Any county, city, or town is hereby authorized to adopt ordinances regulating: 1. The distribution of handbills, leaflets, bulletins, literature, advertisements, or similar material to the
25	occupants of motor vehicles on public roadways and medians;
26	2. The solicitation of contributions of any nature from the occupants of motor vehicles on public
27	roadways and medians; and
28 29	3. The sale of merchandise or the attempted sale of merchandise to the occupants of motor vehicles on public roadways and medians.
30	C. Ordinances adopted pursuant to this section may provide that any person violating the provisions
31	of such ordinances shall be guilty of a traffic infraction.
32	D. The Virginia Department of Transportation may regulate activities within such streets and
33	highways under its jurisdiction, subject to regulations promulgated by the Commonwealth Transportation
34 35	Board. Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow any locality to permit activities within any highway under the maintenance and operational jurisdiction of the Virginia Department of
36	Transportation.
