6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That § 28.2-603 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 28.2-603. General oyster planting grounds; aquaculture opportunity zones.

9 A. Waterfront that is not already assigned or reserved for the riparian owners, and the beds of the 10 bays, rivers, and creeks and shores of the sea lying outside the limits of navigation projects adopted and authorized by the Congress and not required for the disposal of materials dredged incident to the 11 12 maintenance of such projects, and grounds other than public oyster beds, rocks, or shoals, as defined by law and included in the Baylor survey, may be occupied for the purpose of planting or propagating 13 oysters, including the use of temporary protective enclosures in compliance with this chapter and 14 15 Commission regulations, and may be leased by the Commissioner upon the receipt of a proper 16 application.

17 B. The Commission shall establish commercial shellfish aquaculture opportunity zones for the 18 placement of temporary protective enclosures as set forth in § 28.2-603.1, in the waters off the shores of 19 the Northern Neck, the Middle Peninsula, and Tangier Island. Such zones shall be established by 20 regulations. The regulations shall prescribe (i) the location of such zones; (ii) the proper procedures for 21 the maintenance of such zones, including the (a) proper placement and handling of gear and other 22 apparatus so as not to create a safety hazard, and (b) seasonal and time-of-day use of such zones; and 23 (iii) penalties for violations of the regulations. Once established, such zones shall be exempt from the 24 provisions of §§ 28.2-606, 28.2-607, and 28.2-608, §§ 28.2-612 through 28.2-615, and 28.2-617. The 25 Commission may establish a single fee for the application and use of the aquaculture opportunity zones.
