That § 8.01-223.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 8.01-223.1. Use of constitutional rights. In any civil action the exercise by a party of any constitutional protection shall not be used against 11 12 him, except that in any civil proceeding for spousal support, custody, or visitation under Title 16.1 or any civil action for divorce or separate maintenance under Title 20 filed on or after July 1, 2010, if a 13 14 party or witness refuses to answer a question about conduct described in subdivision A (1) of § 20-91 or 15 § 18.2-344 on the ground that the testimony might be self-incriminating, the trier of fact may draw an
