10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:	
11	1. That § 54.1-3481 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:	
12	§ 54.1-3481. Unlawful designation as physical therapist or physical therapist assistant.	
13	A. It shall be unlawful for any person who is not licensed under this chapter, or whose license	
14	been suspended or revoked or who licensure has lapsed and has not been renewed, to use in conjunc	
15	with his name the letters or words "R.P.T.," "Registered Physical Therapist," "L.P.T.," "Licer	
16	Physical Therapist," "P.T.," "Physical Therapist," Physio-therapist," "P.T.T.," "Physical Therapist," Physical Phy	
17	Technician," "P.T.A.," "Physical Therapist Assistant," "Licensed Physical Therapist Assistant," or	
18	otherwise by letters, words, representations or insignias assert or imply that he is a licensed phys	
19	therapist. The title to designate a licensed physical therapist shall be "P.T." The title to designate	te a
20	physical therapist assistant shall show such fact plainly on its face.	

B. It shall be unlawful for any person to advertise or promote services as "physical therapy" or
"physiotherapy" unless those services are provided by a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant
licensed pursuant to this chapter.
