6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 54.1-2811.1, relating to handling
7	of human remains.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 54.1-2811.1 as follows:
10	§ 54.1-2811.1. Handling and storage of human remains.
11	A. Upon taking custody of a dead human body, a funeral service establishment shall maintain such
12	body in a manner that provides complete coverage of the body and that is resistant to leakage or
13	spillage.
14	B. If a dead human body is to be stored for more than 48 hours prior to disposition, a funeral
15	services establishment having custody of such body shall ensure that the dead human body is maintained
16	in refrigeration at 40 degrees Fahrenheit or embalmed.
17	C. If a dead human body is to be stored for more than 10 days prior to disposition at a location
18	other than the funeral service establishment, the funeral service establishment shall disclose to the
1 9	contract buyer the location where the body is to be stored and the method of storage.
20	D. Funeral services establishments, crematories, or transportation services shall not transport animal
2 0 2 1	remains together with dead human bodies. Further, animal remains shall not be refrigerated in a unit
22	where dead human bodies are being stored.
