6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 53.1-105 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 § 53.1-105. County and city regional jail or jail farm; persons who may be confined; release and  
9 transfer of prisoners.

10 Any combination of two or more counties or cities may establish, maintain and operate a regional  
11 jail or jail farm. Any person convicted and sentenced to confinement in the jail or jail farm of such  
12 county or city or sentenced to a state correctional facility may be confined in a regional jail farm and  
13 required to do work as may be assigned him during the term of his sentence. Any regional jail may be  
14 used to hold or confine any person who could lawfully be held or confined in a jail operated and  
15 maintained separately.

16 Subject to the provisions of § 53.1-113 and in the absence of private transportation arranged by the  
17 prisoner, any prisoner, after having completed a term of incarceration and upon release from a regional  
18 jail operated within Planning District Four *or Planning District Five*, shall be transported by such  
19 regional jail to the locality where the prisoner was arrested or convicted.
