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9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 2.2-3808, as it shall become effective, is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 2.2-3808. (Effective July 1, 2010) Collection, disclosure, or display of social security number.
12	A. It shall be unlawful for any agency to:
13	1. Require an individual to disclose or furnish his social security number not previously disclosed or
14	furnished, for any purpose in connection with any activity, or to refuse any service, privilege, or right to
15	an individual wholly or partly because the individual does not disclose or furnish such number, unless
16	the disclosure or furnishing of such number is specifically required by federal or state law in effect prior
17	to January 1, 1975, or is specifically authorized or required by federal law; or
18	2. Collect from an individual his social security number or any portion thereof unless the collection
19	of such number is (i) authorized or required by state or federal law and (ii) essential for the performance
20	of that agency's duties. [Nothing in this subdivision shall be construed to prohibit the collection of a
2 0 2 1	social security number for the sole purpose of complying with the Virginia Debt Collection Act
22	(§ 2.2-4800 et seq.) or the Setoff Debt Collection Act (§ 58.1-520 et seq.).]

24 24	replaced on or after July 1, 2003, shall not display an individual's entire social security number except
25	as provided in § 46.2-703.
2 6	C. Any agency-issued identification card, student identification card, or license certificate that was
27	issued prior to July 1, 2003, and that displays an individual's entire social security number shall be
28	replaced no later than July 1, 2006, except that voter registration cards issued with a social security
29	number and not previously replaced shall be replaced no later than the December 31st following the
3 0	completion by the state and all localities of the decennial redistricting following the 2010 census. This
31	subsection shall not apply to (i) driver's licenses and special identification cards issued by the
32	Department of Motor Vehicles pursuant to Chapter 3 (§ 46.2-300 et seq.) of Title 46.2 and (ii) road tax
33	registrations issued pursuant to § 46.2-703.
34	D. After July 1, 2004, no No agency, as defined in § 42.1-77, shall send or deliver or cause to be
35	sent or delivered, any letter, envelope, or package that displays a social security number on the face of
36	the mailing envelope or package or from which a social security number is visible, whether on the
37	outside or inside of the mailing envelope or package.
38	E. The provisions of subsections A and C shall not be applicable to licenses issued by the State
39	Corporation Commission's Bureau of Insurance until such time as a national insurance producer
40	identification number has been created and implemented in all states. Commencing with the date of such
41	implementation, the licenses issued by the State Corporation Commission's Bureau of Insurance shall be
42	issued in compliance with subsection A of this section. Further, all licenses issued prior to the date of
