11	1. § 1. The Department of State Police, in cooperation with the Secretary of Public Safety, shall
12	develop a plan for the issuance of concealed handgun permits to Virginia residents that are valid for
13	the lifetime of the permittee.
14	§ 2. The plan required by § 1 shall include, but not be limited to:
15	1. A process whereby an applicant shall apply for a concealed handgun permit directly to the
16	Department of State Police, instead of to the clerk of the circuit court of the jurisdiction in which he
17	resides as is currently required by subsection D of § 18.2-308; and
18	2. Once a permit has been issued, a process whereby such permit shall be revoked by the
19	Department of State Police if the permittee is found to have become disqualified to hold a concealed
20	handgun permit pursuant to § 18.2-308.
