12	1. § 1. That the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) shall forthwith reopen any and all
13 14	Interstate Highway System rest areas and VDOT residency offices in the Commonwealth that were
15	closed during 2009. § 2. That VDOT is prohibited from closing any Interstate Highway System welcome center in the
16	Commonwealth in operation on the effective date of this act.
17	2. That the Office of the Secretary of Transportation shall examine options for privatization and
18	alternate funding of rest areas, to include an examination of private sector "adopt-a-rest area"
19	programs and the use of inmate labor to clean and maintain rest areas.
20	3. That any money needed to reopen the rest areas and residency offices shall come from the
21	Central Office of the Virginia Department of Transportation.
