That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 4 of Chapter 29 of Title 54.1 12 sections numbered 54.1-2957.14 and 54.1-2957.15 as follows: 13 14 § 54.1-2957.14. Medical laboratory scientist and medical laboratory technician; definitions. 15 "Medical laboratory scientist" means a person who meets the requirements for registration as a medical laboratory scientist with the Board, and who engages in the development, performance, 16 interpretation, and evaluation of laboratory tests in such areas as hematology, clinical chemistry, 17 immunohematology, microbiology, serology/immunology, coagulation, molecular, and other emerging 18 19 diagnostics. 20 "Medical laboratory technician" means a person who meets the requirements for registration as a medical laboratory technician with the Board, and who performs laboratory tests in such areas as 21 22 hematology, clinical chemistry, immunohematology, microbiology, serology/immunology, coagulation, 23 molecular, and other emerging diagnostics. 24 § 54.1-2957.15. Registration as medical laboratory scientist or medical laboratory technician. 25 A. It shall be unlawful for a person to practice or hold himself out as practicing as a medical laboratory scientist or medical laboratory technician, or to engage in activities defined as constituting 26 27 the practice of a person required to be registered as a medical laboratory scientists or medical 28 laboratory technician as provided in regulations adopted by the Board, unless he has registered with the 29 Board. 30 B. Every applicant for registration as a medical laboratory scientist shall pay the required fee and 31 shall submit written evidence that the applicant: 1. Has received a baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited college or university; 32 33 2. Has satisfactorily completed a program of experience and training required by the American Society of Clinical Pathology Board of Certification, American Medical Technologists, or other 34 35 nationally recognized certification agency; and 3. Has passed a certification examination administered by the American Society for Clinical 36 37 Pathology Board of Registry, the American Medical Technologists, or other nationally recognized 38 credentialing agency. 39 C. Every applicant for registration as a medical laboratory technician shall pay the required fee and 40 shall submit written evidence that the applicant: 41 1. Has received an associates degree or higher from a regionally accredited college or university; 2. Has satisfactorily completed a program of experience and training required by the American 42 Society of Clinical Pathology Board of Certification, American Medical Technologists, or other 43 nationally recognized certification agency; and 44 3. Has passed a certification examination administered by the American Society for Clinical 45 46 Pathology Board of Registry, the American Medical Technologists, or other nationally recognized 47 credentialing agency. D. The Board shall adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this section. 48 49 That the Board of Medicine shall waive requirements related to receipt of the required 2. baccalaureate or associates degree, satisfactory completion of an approved program of experience 50 51 and training, and successful completion of a certification examination for persons seeking 52 registration as a medical laboratory scientist or medical laboratory technician for any person who 53 (i) makes application for registration before July 1, 2011; (ii) otherwise complies with regulations of the Board relating to moral turpitude; and (iii) has at least three years documented work 54 55 experience as a medical laboratory scientist or medical laboratory technician. 56
