3	A BILL to amend and reenact § 36-137 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Board of Housing and
4	Community Development; powers; Virginia Building Code Academy.

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9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 36-137 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 36-137. Powers and duties of Board; appointment of Building Code Academy Advisory
12	Committee.
13	The Board shall exercise the following powers and duties, and such others as may be provided by
14	law:
15	1. Provide a means of citizen access to the Department.
16	2. Provide a means of publicizing the policies and programs of the Department in order to educate
17	the public and elicit public support for Department activities.
18	3. Monitor the policies and activities of the Department and have the right of access to departmental
19	information.
20	4. Advise the Governor and the Director on matters relating to housing and community development.
20 21	5. Make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out its responsibilities and repeal or
22	amend such rules when necessary.
$\frac{12}{23}$	6. Issue a certificate of competence concerning the content, application, and intent of specified
23 24	subject areas of the building and fire prevention regulations promulgated by the Board to present or
25	prospective personnel of local governments and to any other persons seeking to become qualified to
<b>2</b> 6	perform inspections pursuant to Chapter 6 (§ 36-97 et seq.) of this title, Chapter 9 (§ 27-94 et seq.) of
27	Title 27, and any regulations adopted thereunder, who have completed training programs or in other
28	ways demonstrated adequate knowledge.
<b>2</b> 9	7. Levy by regulation up to two percent of building permit fees authorized pursuant to § [§ 36-98.3
30	and ] 36-105 to support training programs of the Building Code Academy established pursuant to
31	§ 36-139. Local building departments shall collect such levy and transmit it quarterly to the Department
32	of Housing and Community Development. Localities that maintain, individual or regional, training
33	academies accredited by the Department of Housing and Community Development shall retain such
34	levy. However, such localities may send employees to training programs of the Building Code Academy
35	upon payment of a fee calculated to cover the cost of such training. Any unspent balance shall be
36	reappropriated each year for the continued operation of the Building Code Academy.
37	The Board shall appoint a Building Code Academy Advisory Committee (the Committee) comprised
38	of representatives of code enforcement personnel and construction industry professions affected by the
39	provisions of the building and fire prevention regulations promulgated by the Board. Members of the
40	Committee shall receive no compensation but shall be entitled to be reimbursed for all reasonable and
41	necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with § 2.2-2813. The
42	Committee shall advise the Board and the Director on policies, procedures, operations, and other matters
43	pertinent to enhancing the delivery of training services provided by the Building Code Academy.
44	8. Establish general policies, procedures, and programs for the Virginia Housing Partnership
45	Revolving Fund established in Chapter 9 (§ 36-141 et seq.) of this title.
46	9. Determine the categories of housing programs, housing sponsors and persons and families of low
47	and moderate income eligible to participate in grant or loan programs of the Virginia Housing
48	Partnership Revolving Fund and designate the proportion of such grants or loans to be made available in
<b>49</b>	each category.
50	10. Advise the Director of the Department on the program guidelines required to accomplish the
51 52	policies and procedures of the Virginia Housing Partnership Revolving Fund.
52 53	11. Advise the Virginia Housing Development Authority on matters relating to the administration and
53 54	management of loans and grants from the Virginia Housing Partnership Revolving Fund.
	12. Establish the amount of the low-income housing credit, the terms and conditions for qualifying for such credit, and the terms and conditions for computing any credit recapture amount for the Virginia
