VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 36-137 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 36-137. Powers and duties of Board; appointment of Building Code Academy Advisory Committee. The Board shall exercise the following powers and duties, and such others as may be provided by

1. Provide a means of citizen access to the Department.

2. Provide a means of publicizing the policies and programs of the Department in order to educate the public and elicit public support for Department activities.

3. Monitor the policies and activities of the Department and have the right of access to departmental 14 15 information.

4. Advise the Governor and the Director on matters relating to housing and community development.

17 5. Make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out its responsibilities and repeal or 18 amend such rules when necessary.

19 6. Issue a certificate of competence concerning the content, application, and intent of specified subject areas of the building and fire prevention regulations promulgated by the Board to present or 20 21 prospective personnel of local governments and to any other persons seeking to become qualified to perform inspections pursuant to Chapter 6 (§ 36-97 et seq.) of this title, Chapter 9 (§ 27-94 et seq.) of 22 23 Title 27, and any regulations adopted thereunder, who have completed training programs or in other 24 ways demonstrated adequate knowledge.

25 7. Levy by regulation up to two percent of building permit fees authorized pursuant to §§ 36-98.3 and 36-105 to support training programs of the Building Code Academy established pursuant to 26 27 § 36-139. Local building departments shall collect such levy and transmit it quarterly to the Department of Housing and Community Development. Localities that maintain, individual or regional, training 28 29 academies accredited by the Department of Housing and Community Development shall retain such 30 levy. However, such localities may send employees to training programs of the Building Code Academy 31 upon payment of a fee calculated to cover the cost of such training. Any unspent balance shall be 32 reappropriated each year for the continued operation of the Building Code Academy.

33 The Board shall appoint a Building Code Academy Advisory Committee (the Committee) comprised of representatives of code enforcement personnel and construction industry professions affected by the 34 provisions of the building and fire prevention regulations promulgated by the Board. Members of the 35 Committee shall receive no compensation but shall be entitled to be reimbursed for all reasonable and 36 37 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with § 2.2-2813. The 38 Committee shall advise the Board and the Director on policies, procedures, operations, and other matters 39 pertinent to enhancing the delivery of training services provided by the Building Code Academy.

40 8. Establish general policies, procedures, and programs for the Virginia Housing Partnership 41 Revolving Fund established in Chapter 9 (§ 36-141 et seq.) of this title.

42 9. Determine the categories of housing programs, housing sponsors and persons and families of low 43 and moderate income eligible to participate in grant or loan programs of the Virginia Housing Partnership Revolving Fund and designate the proportion of such grants or loans to be made available in 44 45 each category.

10. Advise the Director of the Department on the program guidelines required to accomplish the 46 policies and procedures of the Virginia Housing Partnership Revolving Fund. 47

11. Advise the Virginia Housing Development Authority on matters relating to the administration and **48** management of loans and grants from the Virginia Housing Partnership Revolving Fund. 49

50 12. Establish the amount of the low-income housing credit, the terms and conditions for qualifying for such credit, and the terms and conditions for computing any credit recapture amount for the Virginia 51 52 income tax return. 53

13. Serve in an advisory capacity to the Center for Housing Research established by § 23-135.7:14.

54 14. Advise the Department in the development of the Consolidated Plan Strategy to guide and 55 coordinate the housing programs of the Department, the Virginia Housing Development Authority, and 56 other state agencies and instrumentalities.

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15. Advise the Governor and the Department on the expansion of affordable, accessible housing for older Virginians and Virginians with disabilities, including supportive services.
16. Establish guidelines for the allocation of private activity bonds to local housing authorities in accordance with the provisions of the Private Activity Bonds program in Chapter 50 (§ 15.2-5000 et activity bonds to local housing authorities). seq.) of Title 15.2.
