11	1. That § 30-114 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 30-114. Filing of complaints; procedures; disposition.
13	A. In response to the signed and sworn complaint of any citizen of the Commonwealth submitted to
14	the Panel, the Panel shall inquire into any alleged violation of Articles 2 through 5 (§ 30-102 et seq.) of
15	this chapter by any member of the respective house of the General Assembly in his current term or his
16	immediate prior term. Complaints shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Legislative Services,
17	who shall promptly submit the complaint to the chairman of the appropriate Panel. The Panel may use
18	the Director of the Division of Legislative Services, and such additional staff as he may assign, to assist
19	the Panel during its preliminary investigation.
20	B. If after such preliminary investigation as it may make, the Panel determines to proceed with an
21	inquiry into the conduct of any legislator, the Panel shall immediately notify in writing the individual as
22	to the fact of the inquiry and the charges against him and shall schedule one or more hearings on the
23	matter. The legislator shall have the right to present evidence, cross-examine witnesses, face and
24	examine the accuser, and be represented by counsel at any hearings. In its discretion, the Panel may
25	grant the legislator any other rights or privileges not specifically enumerated in this subsection, and, in
26	addition, may hold hearings in closed session. However, the legislator whose conduct is under inquiry,
27	by written request filed with the Panel, may require that all hearings before the Panel concerning the
