Unauthorized installation or placement of electronic tracking device in motor vehicle. 14 15 Any person who, with the intent to electronically track the location of a motor vehicle, knowingly 16 installs or places an electronic tracking device, or causes an electronic tracking device to be installed or placed, in or on a motor vehicle without the consent of an owner, or the lessee of the motor vehicle, 17 18 is guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor. 19 For the purposes of this section, the term "motor vehicle" has the same meaning set forth in **20** *§* 46.2-100.

This provision does not apply to:
1. The original manufacturer of the motor vehicle.
2. A law-enforcement officer, judicial officer, probation or parole officer, or employee of the

Department of Corrections with the authority to do so in the lawful performance of official duties.

3. A bail bondsman or bail enforcement agent licensed by the Department of Criminal Justice Services acting in the course of his legitimate business.
