12	If any person shall use Any person who uses obscene, vulgar, profane, lewd, lascivious, or indecent
13	language, or make makes any suggestion or proposal of an obscene nature, or threatens any
14	illegal or immoral act with the intent to coerce, intimidate, or harass any person, over any telephone or
15	citizens band radio, in this Commonwealth, he shall be is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
	childens band radio, in this common weath, no shah be is guilty of a chass i misdemeanor.

16 "Over any telephone" includes, for purposes of this section, any electronically transmitted message 17 that is received or transmitted by telephone.
