B. Upon the first conviction of a dealer for violation of any provision of this chapter, the chief law-enforcement officer [ may *shall* ] revoke the dealer's permit for one full year from the date the conviction becomes final. Such revocation shall be mandatory *for two full years from the date the conviction becomes final* upon a second conviction.
