	§ 2.2-1102. Additional powers of Department.
13	A. The Department shall have the following additional powers, all of which, with the approval of the
14	Director of the Department, may be exercised by a division of the Department with respect to matters
15	assigned to that division:
16	1. Prescribe regulations necessary or incidental to the performance of duties or execution of powers
17	conferred under this chapter; and
18	2. Establish fee schedules that may be collectible from users when general fund appropriations are
19 20	not applicable to the services rendered. B. All statewide contracts and agreements made and entered into by the Department for the purchase
20 21	of computers, software, supplies, and related peripheral equipment and services shall provide for the
22	inclusion of counties, cities, and towns in such contracts and agreements. For good cause shown, the
23	Secretary of Administration may disapprove the inclusion from a specific contract or agreement.
23 24	C. The Department may operate or provide for the operation of hazardous waste management
25	facilities.
26	D. The Department shall establish a fee schedule limited to 0.5 percent of the total purchase order
27	for all procurement contracts made with its web-based electronic procurement program commonly
28	known as "eVA." No registration fee shall be required for vendors to participate in the electronic
29	procurement program.
