10103470D **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 156** 1 2 House Amendments in [] - February 1, 2010 3 [Recognizing Designating] January 29 [,] in 2010 [and in each succeeding year,] as National 4 Earned Income Tax Credit Awareness Day. 5 Patron Prior to Engrossment-Delegate Toscano 6 7 Referred to Committee on Rules 8 9 WHEREAS, the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) was established in 1975 to assist working people 10 who earn low or moderate incomes; and WHEREAS, the EITC is the federal government's largest benefits program for working families, with 11 24.6 million American families and individuals claiming Earned Income Tax Credits worth \$48.7 billion 12 13 in 2009; and WHEREAS, in 2009, 533,884 eligible Virginians claimed an average EITC refund of \$1,900, for a 14 15 total of more than \$1 billion in credits claimed; and WHEREAS, these Virginians are simply recovering monies to which they are entitled and which 16 have been withheld from their paycheck; and 17 WHEREAS, these monies help fund the critical needs of families while injecting money into local 18 19 economies; and 20 WHEREAS, according to national estimates, 15 to 20 percent of eligible workers do not claim 21 federal Earned Income Tax Credit benefits; and WHEREAS, in a weak economy, many working individuals and families have faced unemployment 22 23 or have seen their incomes decline steeply, making it critical this year more than ever that eligible 24 citizens be aware of and able to claim tax credits like the EITC; now, therefore, be it 25
