10	nonprofit employment service organizations the ability to provide goods and services to state and local
11	bodies on a noncompetitive basis; and
12	WHEREAS, employment service organizations have a vendorship agreement with the Virginia
13	Department of Rehabilitative Services; and
14 15	WHEREAS, the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA) allows state and local public bodies to procure goods and services from nonprofit employment service organizations without the need for
16	competition; and
17	WHEREAS, nonprofit service organizations provide various services including but not limited to
18	document management as well as document destruction services; and
19 20	WHEREAS, nonprofit employment service organizations provide work environments as well as social
20 21	interaction for Virginia's most vulnerable citizens; and WHEREAS, state and local public bodies underutilize goods and services provided by nonprofit
22	employment service organizations; now, therefore, be it
