WHEREAS, Sally Thomas won four successive terms to the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors and served as chair from 2001 to 2002; and

WHEREAS, Sally Thomas has served and been active in numerous local, state, and national organizations throughout her career, including as a gubernatorial appointee to the Chesapeake Bay Program's Local Government Advisory Commission; and

WHEREAS, Sally Thomas will long be appreciated as a progressive and visionary leader in rural protection and promotion of smart growth, as well as a champion of public participation in local government; now, therefore, be it
