WHÉREAS, recruited by St. Anne's-Belfield School as the junior varsity boys' lacrosse team coach,
 Doug Tarring became head varsity coach in 1979; and

WHEREAS, not only an outstanding coach, Doug Tarring has been an inspirational role model,
mentor, and leader of hundreds of young men throughout the years; he has encouraged and helped them
grow and develop not just on the field but personally as well; and

WHEREAS, an enthusiastic leader and advocate, Doug Tarring has been influential in the growth in popularity of lacrosse locally and across the state; and

WHEREAS, Doug Tarring has received numerous accolades and honors throughout his career,
 including Division 1 Coach of the Year in 2008 and 2009 and inclusion in the Virginia Lacrosse Hall of
 Fame; and

WHEREAS, Doug Tarring's program has produced numerous collegiate-level players and over 30 high school All-Americans; the back-to-back state championship wins of the St. Anne's-Belfield boys' lacrosse team were a fitting end to a stellar coaching career; and

WHEREAS, Doug Tarring's success was bolstered by the support of the St. Anne's-Belfield
community of parents, administrators, faculty, and students; the players' loyalty and commitment to the
program; and the dedication, friendship, and positive impact of the coaching staff; now, therefore, be it
