18	Section 7-B. Limit on appropriations.	
19	The General Assembly shall not make total appropriations for any fiscal year that exceed the total	
20	appropriations for the immediately preceding fiscal year by a percentage greater than the percentage	
21	increase in the rate of inflation for the most recently available year, plus the percentage increase in	
22	state population, both as shall be defined by general law, except appropriations made (i) for tax relief,	_
23	(ii) for deposits to the Revenue Stabilization Fund, or (iii) for nonrecurring capital projects. For	HJ26
24	purposes of this section, "total appropriations" means all appropriations except for any moneys	26
25	appropriated that are received from the federal government or an agency or unit thereof. The General	
26	Assembly may exceed this limitation only by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members	
27	elected to each house of the General Assembly.	
28	The General Assembly shall enact such laws as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this	
29	section.
