WHEREAS, Zion Baptist Church is known for its numerous outreach ministries that focus on the growth and well-being of the Portsmouth community and its citizens in need, including tutoring local children and serving breakfast to the homeless three days a week; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 the entire congregation and community was shocked and saddened when a devastating fire destroyed historic Zion Baptist Church's entire sanctuary along with neighboring buildings; and

WHEREAS, the strong and faithful congregation has continued to press "Ever Onward" as it meets in a different location, works to rebuild the sanctuary and other buildings, and perseveres in the teaching and preaching of God's word; and

WHEREAS, Zion Baptist Church will honor its 145th anniversary of service to the Lord and the community with celebratory activities during the weekend of March 12 - 14, 2010; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend and congratulate Zion Baptist Church on the occasion of its 145th anniversary; and, be it
