10103910D **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 67** 1 2 Offered January 13, 2010 3 Prefiled January 11, 2010 4 5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article X a section numbered 7-B. relating to special funds for transportation purposes. 6 Patron-Marshall, R.G. 7 8 Referred to Committee on Privileges and Elections 9 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, a majority of the members elected to 10 each house agreeing, That the following amendment to the Constitution of Virginia be, and the same 11 hereby is, proposed and referred to the General Assembly at its first regular session held after the next 12 general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the 13 provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely: 14 15 Amend the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article X a section numbered 7-B as follows: 16 ARTICLE X TAXATION AND FINANCE 17 Section 7-B. Transportation Funds. 18 (a) The General Assembly shall maintain permanent and separate Transportation Funds. The 19 20 Commonwealth Transportation Fund, Transportation Trust Fund, Highway Maintenance and Operating 21 Fund, any other Fund established by general law for transportation, and all subsidiary accounts and 22 parts thereof, shall be deemed Transportation Funds for purposes of this section. 23 (b) There shall be deposited to the Transportation Funds all revenues dedicated to the 24 Transportation Funds under provisions of general law, but excluding a general appropriation law, in 25 effect on January 1, 2009. However, the General Assembly may by general law, but excluding a general 26 appropriation law, make changes to the revenues dedicated and paid into the Transportation Funds. 27 Money in the Transportation Funds may be invested as authorized by law. 28 (c) All moneys deposited to the Transportation Funds shall be appropriated from the Transportation 29 Funds only for purposes of (i) financing, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining, and operating 30 transportation systems and projects in the Commonwealth, and all purposes incidental thereto; (ii) 31 furthering the interests of the Commonwealth in highways, public transportation, railways, seaports, and airports; and (iii) providing for the operations of state agencies, political subdivisions, or authorities 32 33 related to transportation. 34 (d) The General Assembly may borrow from Transportation Funds for other purposes only by a vote 35 equal to or greater than two-thirds plus one of the members voting in each house, including a majority 36 of the members elected to that house. The name of each member voting and how he voted shall be 37 recorded in the journal of each house. Any amount borrowed shall be repaid to the Transportation 38 Funds, with reasonable interest, not later than the end of the fourth full fiscal year following the 39 effective date of the borrowing.
