11	1. That § 19.2-185 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
<b>12</b>	§ 19.2-185. Testimony may be reduced to writing and subscribed.
13	When the judge deems it proper, the testimony of the witnesses may be reduced to writing, and, if
14	required by him, shall be signed by them respectively.
15	The judge of the court of record to which the case may be or has been certified, or the district court
16	judge conducting the preliminary hearing, may order the testimony of the witnesses at the preliminary
