10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:	
11	1. That § 22.1-132.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:	
12	§ 22.1-132.2. Integrated pest management on school property.	
13	The Department of Education shall make information available to school boards on integrated pes	
14	management programs that appropriately address the application of chemical pesticides and other pes	
15	control measures on school property. For purposes of this section, "integrated pest management" shall	
16	mean a managed pest control and suppression program that uses various integrated methods to keep	
17	pests from causing economic, health-related, or aesthetic injury and minimizes the use of pesticides and	
18	the risk to human health and the environment associated with pesticide applications. Methods may	
19	include the utilization of site or pest inspections, pest population monitoring, evaluation of contro	
20	requirements, and the use of one or more pest control methods including sanitation, structural repair	
21	nonchemical methods, and pesticides when nontoxic options produce unsatisfactory results or ar	
22	impractical. Each local school division shall maintain documentation of any pesticide application that	
23 24	includes the target pest, the formulation applied, and the specific location of the application. The mudalines and programs adopted pursuant to this section shall permit the immediate application of
