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11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 67-700 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted, and that the Code of Virginia
13	is amended by adding in Chapter 7 of Title 67 a section numbered 67-702, as follows:
14	CHAPTER 7.
15	COVENANTS RESTRICTING SOLAR ENERGY COLLECTION AND NATURAL DRYING DEVICES.
16	§ 67-700. Definitions.
17 18	As used in this chapter:
10 19	"Community association" means an unincorporated association or corporation that owns or has under its care, custody, or control real estate subject to a recorded declaration of covenants that obligates a
20	person, by virtue of ownership of specific real estate, to be a member of the unincorporated association
20 21	or corporation.
22	"Natural drying device" means any device, such as a clothesline, or any combination of devices, that
23	uses naturally-occurring wind or evaporation to dry clothes, linens, or other fabrics.
24	"Solar energy collection device" means any device manufactured and sold for the sole purpose of
25	facilitating the collection and beneficial use of solar energy, including passive heating panels or building
26	components and solar photovoltaic apparatus.
27	§ 67-702. Covenants regarding renewable energy resource device.
28	A. Effective July 1, 2010, no community association shall prohibit an owner from installing or using
29	a natural drying device on that owner's property. However, a community association may establish
30	reasonable restrictions concerning the size, placement, and manner of placement of such natural drying
31	device.
32	B. The community association may prohibit or restrict the installation of natural drying devices on
33	the common elements or common area within the real estate development served by the community
34 35	association. A community association may establish reasonable restrictions as to the size, placement,
35 36	and manner of placement or installation of any natural drying device installed on the common elements or common area.
30 37	C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to (i) invalidate any provision of a restrictive covenant
38	that prohibits or restricts the installation or use of any natural drying device if such provision was in
39	effect before July 1, 2010, or (ii) prohibit the amendment of a restrictive covenant to prohibit or restrict
40	the installation or use of any natural drying device, or to remove prohibitions or restrictions on the
41	installation or use of any natural drying device if such amendment is adopted by the membership of the
42	community association in accordance with such association's governing documents.
