2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 22.1-348 of the Code of Virginia, relating to persons eligible for the*
3 *Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 22.1-348 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 22.1-348. Persons eligible; fees; educational programs to be provided; admissions procedures.

9 A. Persons ~~of ages two from birth~~ through ~~twenty-one~~ age 21 shall be eligible for educational
10 services provided by the school. The Department of Education shall be entitled to deduct annually from
11 the locality's share for the education of pupils with disabilities a sum equal to the actual local
12 expenditure per pupil in support of those students placed by the relevant local school division in the
13 Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind. The amount of the actual transfers shall be based on data
14 accumulated during the prior school year. Fees for student activities may be charged at the Board's
15 discretion.

16 B. From such funds as may be appropriated, the Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind shall
17 provide an educational program for children in preschool through grade twelve who are deaf, blind, or
18 who may have sensory impairments and other disabilities, including intellectual disabilities.

19 The Board, from time to time, may approve additional programs as may be appropriate.

20 C. The Board shall prescribe procedures and criteria for determining admission to and the appropriate
21 placement in the Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind. The appropriateness of the placement of
22 each student attending the school shall be reviewed at least annually.

23 **2. That any additional fiscal impact pursuant to the provisions of this act shall be funded from**
24 **existing appropriations to the Virginia School for the Deaf and Blind.**
