6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-931 of the Code of Virginia, relating to distribution of handbills,
7	etc., solicitation of contributions, and sale of merchandise or services on highways, public roadways,
8	and medians.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10 11	1. That § 46.2-931 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 46.2-931. Localities may prohibit or regulate distribution of handbills, etc., solicitation of contributions, and sale of merchandise or services on highways within their boundaries or on public
12	roadways and medians.
13 14	A. Arlington, Hanover, Henrico, and Spotsylvania Counties, the Cities of Falls Church and
15	Richmond, and the Town of Vienna are Any county, city, or town is hereby authorized to adopt
16	ordinances an ordinance prohibiting or regulating:
17	1. The distribution of handbills, leaflets, bulletins, literature, advertisements, or similar material to the
18	occupants of motor vehicles on highways located within their its boundaries or on public roadways and
19	medians;
20	2. The solicitation of contributions of any nature from the occupants of motor vehicles on highways
21	located within their its boundaries or on public roadways and medians; and
22	3. The sale of merchandise or services or the attempted sale of merchandise or services to the
23 24	occupants of motor vehicles on highways located within their its boundaries or on public roadways and
24 25	B. Albemarle, Greene, Hanover, Loudoun, and Spotsylvania Counties and the Cities of Falls Church
23 26	and Richmond are hereby authorized to adopt ordinances regulating:
2 7	1. The distribution of handbills, leaflets, bulletins, literature, advertisements, or similar material to the
28	occupants of motor vehicles on public roadways and medians;
29	2. The solicitation of contributions of any nature from the occupants of motor vehicles on public
30	roadways and medians; and
31	3. The sale of merchandise or the attempted sale of merchandise to the occupants of motor vehicles
32	on public roadways and medians.
33	C. Ordinances adopted pursuant to this section may provide that any person violating the provisions
34 35	of such ordinances shall be guilty of a traffic infraction. DC. The Virginia Department of Transportation may regulate activities within such streets and
33 36	highways under its jurisdiction, subject to regulations promulgated by the Commonwealth Transportation
37	Board. Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow any locality to permit activities within any
38	highway under the maintenance and operational jurisdiction of the Virginia Department of
39	Transportation.
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
