15	by his designee, stating that after a diligent search, no record or entry of such record is found to exist
16	among the records in his custody, is admissible as evidence that his office has no such record or entry,
17	provided that the procedures set forth in subsection G of § 18.2-472.1 for admission of an affidavit have
18	been satisfied, mutatis mutandis, and the accused has not objected to the admission of the affidavit
