2	AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
3	(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Transportation
4	on February 4, 2010)
5	(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Petersen)
6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-749.3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates for
7	clean special fuel vehicles.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 46.2-749.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 46.2-749.3. Special license plates for clean special fuel vehicles.
11	A. The owner of any motor vehicle, except a motorcycle, that may utilize clean special fuel may
12	purchase special license plates indicating the motor vehicle utilizes clean special fuels. Upon receipt of
13	an application, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the owners of such vehicles.
13 14	For those motor vehicles required by law to display official government-use license plates, the
14	Commissioner shall provide by regulation for the issuance, display, and fee for issuance of an alternative
15 16	device indicating that the vehicle displaying the device is a clean special fuel vehicle. For the purposes
17	of § 33.1-46.2, vehicles displaying such a device as provided in such regulation shall be treated as
18	vehicles displaying special license plates issued under this section.
19	As used in this section, "clean special fuel" means any product or energy source used to propel a
20	highway vehicle, the use of which, compared to conventional gasoline or reformulated gasoline, results
2 0 2 1	in lower emissions of oxides of nitrogen, volatile organic compounds, carbon monoxide or particulates
22	or any combination thereof. The term includes compressed natural gas, liquefied natural gas, liquefied
23	petroleum gas, hydrogen, electrolytic oxy-hydrogen injection (and combination of oxy-hydrogen and
23 24	gasoline or diesel), hythane (a combination of compressed natural gas and hydrogen), and electricity.
25	On and after July 1, 2006, license plates provided for in this section shall be issued with a new
2 6	design distinctively different from the design of license plates issued to owners of vehicles that qualify
27	for license plates under this section whose applications are received by the Department prior to July 1,
28	2006. The distinctively different design shall be developed by the Department in consultation with the
29	Department of State Police.
3 0	1. For the purposes of subdivision A 6 of § 33.1-46.2, on HOV lanes serving the I-95/395 and
31	164/264 corridors, only vehicles registered with and displaying special license plates issued under this
32	section prior to July 1, 2006, shall be treated as vehicles displaying special license plates issued under
33	this section.
34	2. That the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles, in consultation with the Motor
35	Vehicle Dealer Board, shall develop procedures to ensure that all potential purchasers of clean special
36	fuel vehicles receive adequate notice of the benefits, risks and timelines required for the issuance of
37	clean special fuel vehicle license plates.
38	B. The With the exception of plates issued to government-use vehicles, the annual fee for plates
39	issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed fee for state license plates. For
40	each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, \$15 shall be paid to
41	the State Treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known as the HOV Enforcement Fund,
42	established within the Department of Accounts, for use by the Virginia State Police for enhanced HOV
43	enforcement. The fee for plates issued pursuant to this section to government-use vehicles shall be as
44	prescribed in subsection A of § 46.2-750.

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
