6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-268.13, relating to DUI prior
7	offenses; penalties.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-268.13 as follows:
10	§ 18.2-268.13. Driving under the influence; definition of substantially similar laws for determining
11	number of prior offenses.
12	A statute or ordinance of another state, the United States, or a political subdivision of either, that
13	criminalizes driving or operating a motor vehicle with a prohibited blood alcohol content of .08 percent
14	or more by weight by volume or .08 grams or more per 210 liters of breath shall be deemed to be a
15	substantially similar law for the purpose of determining the number of offenses committed by a person
16	and the punishment appropriate pursuant to clause (ii) of subsection E of § 18.2-270. In addition, a
17	driving under the influence conviction in a state contiguous to the Commonwealth or in the District of
18	Columbia shall be deemed to be a substantially similar law for the purpose of determining the number
19 20	of offenses committed by a person and the punishment appropriate pursuant to clause (ii) of subsection $E_{1} \leq S \leq S \leq 2$
20	E of § $18.2-270$ .
21 22	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0
23	for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of

24 commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
